


Brixham is a very special place sitting on the South Devon coast making up part of the wonderful destination that is the English Riviera.

- **Breakwater** is our town beach, not sandy but in an amazing spot with easy parking.
- Fishcombe Cove Small but beautifully made.
 Access does include steps.
- Shoalstone Beach Not far from Breakwater and is next door to our amazing Shoalstone Outdoor Pool.
 - St Marys Bay A lovely beach with fab rock pools, sand and shingle. Access does include steps.
- Man Sands A wonderful hidden gem, no real car access but, if you are a walker, it can't be beaten.

Brixham is an idea place for walking and offers routes and trails for all ages and abilities

The town is situated on the South West Coast Path route which covers some 630 miles in total. The path can be testing in some places so good walking shoes or boots are recommended for this route and other walks in the area.

Berry Head and Sharkham Point offers some spectacular trails and Battery Gardens mixes walking with history. A evening stroll around the harbour finishing at Breakwater beach is ideal as a taster route.
